
One night I had a little visitor tree frog came skipping across the floor covered with Nobby's dog hair so I cleaned him up.





Why do a Criminal Pardon (Record Suspension)?

A Canadian pardon is a method of removing a past criminal offense from public record.

A pardon decision is made by the Canadian Parole Board after they review the nature of the prior criminal offenses and documentary evidence relating to "rehabilitation" and other factors that justify a pardon.

Advantages to receiving a Record Suspension:

- Proud to have no further record of past foolishness
- Improve your life, travel and work when applying for a job and records check
- People deserve the right for personal growth and to better themselves

- Stress free travel across international borders confidently and undergo any work related security checks that may be required in the future—Relief from deportation
- Freedom to achieve emotional and psychological closure removing any self-induced humiliation associated with the past events—Forgiveness of past mistakes—No secret shame.

Everyone makes mistakes. Sometimes those mistakes lead to a criminal record.

Over 4 million Canadians have a criminal record; rest assured

you are not alone. Everyone has a legal story. You can apply for you own record suspension but the paperwork and procedure can be daunting.

The process can take 18 to 24 months.

This means you can explore a whole new world of job opportunities or enjoy the freedom to travel to any of your favourite destinations. Insurance companies, financial institutions, apartment rentals, being bonded, contractors hiring sub contracts, educational opportunities, and volunteer organizations are all requesting criminal records checks more frequently now.

To be eligible to receive a pardon in Ontario means an application in Canada to meet the requirements as listed; it must be 3, 5 or 10 years since you completed the sentence for your offense, depending on the type of offense convicted and the seriousness of the crime committed. This time frame includes the completion of all probation

and the payment of all fines.

If you have a non-conviction record holding you back from enjoying life it would be useful to get a Record Purge.

Even if you have never been convicted of a crime, a registered background check can still show a non-conviction record on your criminal records check. This could stop you from finding work, adopting a child, or even travelling freely across the border.

To be considered personally eligible for a Record Purge:

- You must not be convicted of a summary or indictable offense.
- In the case of a discharge, your record must originate before July 24, 1992.
- You must not have a criminal case pending before the courts. This includes courts in other jurisdictions.
- Criminal activity would pose a substantial hurdle to a record removal process since local police have a say in the matter.



TIP TOP TOES

Hello! It's Audrey, the foot care nurse...it's here! It's finally here...SUMMER! One benefit of summer in the Ottawa Valley is knowing that instead of trying to keep frostbite at bay, you can relax with your toes digging bare foot in the sand at the cottage or the many beaches. But remember you can seriously sunburn your feet, and no matter where you are athlete's foot can lay waiting at any pool.

Remember to be sun savvy and foot careful this summer with these helpful hints: Limit walking barefoot as it exposes feet to sunburn, as well as plantar warts, athlete's foot, ringworm, and other infections and also increases risk of injury to your feet.

Wear shoes or flip-flops around the pool, to the beach, or in the change room to prevent injuries and limit the likelihood of contracting any bacterial infections. Remember to apply waterproof sunscreen all over your feet, especially the tops and fronts of ankles, and don't forget to reapply after you've been in the water. And remember a SPF over 30 is recommended. This should be my mantra, I know all of my patients may tire of me preaching this, but stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water throughout the day. This will not only help with overall health, but will also minimize any foot swelling caused by the heat. Keep blood flowing with periodic ankle flexes, toe wiggles, and calf stretches. Some activities at the beach, lake or river may require different types of footwear to be worn. To be safe, always pack an extra pair of sneakers or water shoes. If your shoes will be getting wet, they should be dried out completely before your next wearing to prevent bacteria or fungus from growing. If you injure your foot or ankle while on vacation, seek professional medical attention.

In case of minor foot problems, be prepared with the following on-the-go foot gear:

Flip flops—for the pool, spa, hotel room, and airport security check points. Sterile bandages—for covering minor cuts and scrapes.

Emollient-enriched cream—to hydrate feet.

Blister pads or moleskin—to protect against blisters.

Motrin or Advil (anti-inflammatory)—to ease tired, swollen feet.

Toenail clippers—to keep toenails trimmed.

Emery board—to smooth rough edges or broken nails.

Pumice stone—to soften callused skin.

Sunscreen—to protect against the scorching sun.

Aloe vera—to relieve sunburns.

Remember to check your feet daily, especially those with diabetes or any other ailment that causes a decrease in foot sensitivity. I always recommend using a hand mirror to see all areas. Summer is such a short season, please take are of your feet so that you can enjoy every last minute of it...and if you are having difficulty, you can always visit a foot care nurse...like ME!!!
